ABOUT THIS POSITION

The Water Services Department seeks a creative and energetic individual to assist with water infrastructure and resource planning. The individual will focus on identifying how new and existing development impacts water and wastewater service, and what associated facilities, resources and costs are needed to provide service. This individual may work on impact fees, repayment agreements, development agreements, water use and wastewater generation studies, development/infrastructure sequencing, resource and facility costs, water rate analyses, and land use analyses. This individual will also likely be analyzing and assessing how changes in technology, behavior and land development patterns may influence residential and non-residential water demand and wastewater generation trends. The position would be ideal for a person with an understanding of the interrelationship between land development, water infrastructure and water supplies.

- Five years of experience in water supply, water demand management, water-use information collection and analysis, and/or related field. Three years of experience equivalent to a Planner II in water or natural resource planning.
