

Faculty Associate (Job 11804)

These positions are one semester appointments, part time, non-benefits eligible with no tenure implications. Successful candidates will deliver face to face and/or on-line courses. Positions may be available in the following fields: Human/Cultural Geography, Physical Geography, GIS, Climatology and Urban Planning. Diversity is a key component of excellence at ASU, and the School of Geographical Sciences and Urban Planning supports the value of diversity among faculty, staff and students.

Required qualifications:

- Master's degree in geography, planning or a related field by time of appointment.
- Experience teaching undergraduate geography or planning courses in person and on-line.

Desired qualification:

- PhD in geography, planning or a related field
