#### Brewery / Distillery Van Tour

During this van tour, learn about the development and operations of brewers and distilleries in Flagstaff, including an overview and discussion with Michael Marquess, Neil Gullickson, and John Saltonstall.

Flagstaff has become a leading city for small scale beer and alcohol production, with eight operating breweries, one meadery, and one distillery. The tour will include two one-hour tours of local alcohol production operations with the proprietors, as well as planning and economic development staff from the city. You will learn how the businesses evolved, the technical demands of their craft, the legal issues in Arizona, and the successes and challenges that the city has experienced in supporting and promoting this growing industry.

#### Mill Town to Milton Road: The Evolution of Flagstaff's Gateway Throughout the 20th Century

A walking tour will leave from campus and visit Riordan Mansion State Historic Park which was the heart of the small, territorial logging town known as Mill Town. The



Riordan residence was designed by the creator of Grand Canyon's El Tovar Hotel, Charles Whittlesey, for the family that owned the Arizona Lumber & Timber Company. The historic building is an Arizona treasure — a remarkable example of Arts and Crafts style architecture featuring a rustic exterior of log-slab siding, volcanic stone arches, and hand-split wooden shingles.

From the mansion, the tour will take you on a pictorial history of Mill Town and Milton Road led the Arizona Historical Society (AZHS) and the Flagstaff Metropolitan Planning Organization. Sacha Siskonen and Jill Hough from AZHS will take you into Mill Town's past to discuss the places and people that shaped the community. David Wessel from the FMPO will provide background on the modern-day challenges of Milton Road and the planning underway for this area next evolution.

### **Picture Canyon Hiking Tour with Goats**

Picture Canyon Natural and Cultural Preserve, located 15 minutes from downtown Flagstaff, is a natural and cultural amenity in northern Arizona. Picture Canyon serves as critical riparian habitat, a popular recreation area, and home to significant cultural resources. Visit the 478-acre Preserve to learn about wildlife, ecology, geology, and archaeology while participating in outdoor recreation. The city acquired the property from Arizona State Lands Department in 2012 and has developed a system of trails and volunteers that brings this magical and prehistoric place to life.
